"The Lord ascended on high and gave gifts to men. Paul has Psalm 68:18 and all of Psalm 68 on his mind as he writes Ephesians. Read Psalm 68 and using the table below reflect on the image of Jesus descending into a world ruled by evil, conquering it, and then ascending back to heaven as a victorious King. Jesus has given power and might to his people so that you can serve. Go serve someone today."

Comparing Ephesians to Psalm 68

SUBJECT	PSALMS	EPHESIANS
There is a spiritual enemy	68:15,30	2:2a
We belonged to the spiritual enemy	68:18	2:2b-3
Our King rescued us from the spiritual enemy	68:1-3	2:4-6
He creates family	68:5-6	1:5
He rescues the dead	68:20	2:1 & 2:5
The King is rich	68:12, 18, 29, 30	1:20-23
Our King has given to us out of his riches	68:10, 35	1:18-19 & 2:6-7

⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism, ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

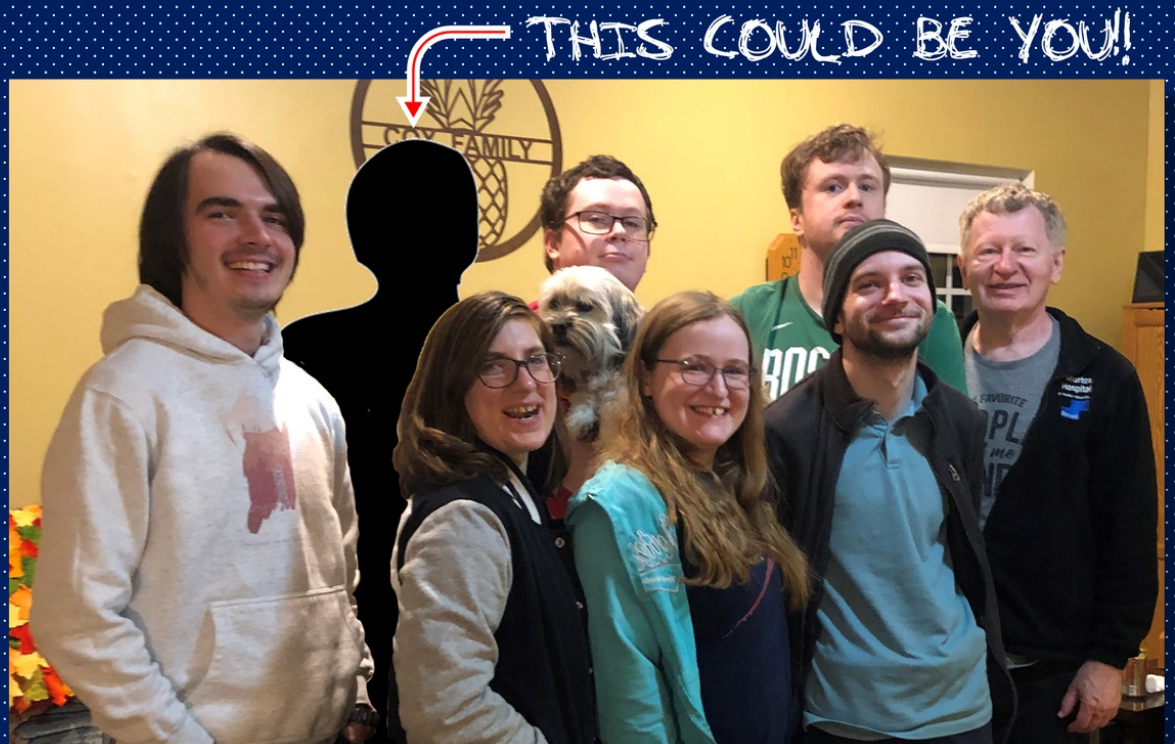


